## Exploring Strategic and Horizontal Activities

### **Overall Outcome:**

- Very Vivid and Constructive Discussion with Broad Participation
- WG2 confirmed the Vision of the IKMS



## Components

- Additional component suggested: Knowledge transfer to less advanced programmes
- Main (quantitatively) interest in 3 components:
  - ✓ State of Knowledge handbook
  - ✓ Training
  - ✓ Guidance
- Dissemination and Strategic Studies received important Input



## Key Outcome - Handbook:

- Structure:
  - ✓ Focus on Managing Knowledge by Experts for Experts
  - ✓ Managing Knowledge for implementing of the overall integrated system
  - ✓ Quality management needed
  - ✓ Content is organized and updated
    - When R&D projects are implemented -> The involved Experts should establish the and update the State-of-Knowledge
- Tool
  - ✓ Wiki possible tool



## Key Outcome – Training and Education:

- No training that is already available will be provided (several existing E&T initiatives like PETRUS III)
- The Programme on Horizontal Activities will provide Links to existing initiatives
  - Specific training request for R&D project will be provided
- To be further discussed:
  - ✓ ENEN proposal to complement their activities to meet needs of the JP
  - ✓ Integrate SITEX proposal to co-structure training to be offered on safety case review



## Key Outcome - Guidance

- JP will not offer guidance that is already available (existing guidance by IAEA, NEA...)
- The WG on horizontal activities will propose a systematic approach to select guidance needs and organize work
- To be further discussed:
  - ✓ Mechanism for identifying need for Guidance still needed



## Key Outcome - Dissemination:

- Common view on:
  - ✓ Dissemination from expert community to expert community
- To be further discussed:
  - ✓ Dissemination to other Expert Communities
  - ✓ Dissemination of R&D outcomes to Policy Makers
  - ✓ Dissemination to the Public





## Key Outcome – Strategic Studies

- Proposals of strategic studies on:
  - ✓ Approach to shared facilities (pre-disposal and repositories)
  - ✓ Options for waste disposal for different types of Waste Inventories
  - ✓ Evolvment in involving Civil Society
  - ✓ Translate ERDO WG initiative to R&D topics



## **Key Outcome – Knowledge Transfer between Programmes**

- Agreement on the Importance
- How to implement: Still pending



## **Working Group 2: Final remarks and way ahead**

- Outcomes of WG2 are in line with the work of the JOPRAD WG for horizontal activities
